LEGAL UPDATE: A response was received from the Airport, and everyone will receive a copy of the letter after our Attorneys can review it and suggest a strategy in moving forward. Terry Lewis was asked to review both our letter and the Airport's letter and give an opinion.

PRIORITY PROJECTS: Our health insurance representative was contacted and asked to prepare a detailed analysis of our current program and other options that the Board may want to consider. The carrier is polling all Districts to determine what is being offered their staffs.

Out of District rates and fees are being reviewed by staff and recommendations will be made during the budget process. FRWA is once again helping us.

OPERATIONAL UPDATE (CLAY): Pugh Utilities is on the agenda for discussion, as well as the status of staff evaluations.
