

RESOLUTION 2026-11

**A Resolution of the Spring Lake Improvement District (SLID) Board OF SUPERVISORS Pertaining to
ESTABLISHING NO WAKE ZONE AT ARBUCKLE CREEK PARK BOAT RAMP**

Wednesday June 17, 2026

WHEREAS, the Spring Lake Improvement District (hereinafter "District") was created by the Florida Legislature and codified in Chapter 1971-669, Laws of Florida, as amended by Chapter 2005-342, Laws of Florida, as amended by Chapter 2012-264, Laws of Florida, pursuant to the authority granted therein and;

WHEREAS, Chapter 298 of the Florida Statutes authorizes the Board of Supervisors, hereinafter referred to as the "Board", of the Spring Lake Improvement District, hereinafter referred to as "District", to prescribe, and establish policies and procedures for the district and;

WHEREAS, the Board wishes to establish the idle speed minimum wake zone in Arbutle Creek adjacent to the District Park on the south end of the creek and:

WHEREAS, a Public Hearing was held at the April 8, 2026, Board meeting held at the District Office and;

WHEREAS, Florida Statute 327.46 authorizes the establishment of no wake zones and;

WHEREAS, the Board wishes to establish a no-wake zone at Arbutle Creek Park Boat Ramp. No person shall operate a vessel at a speed that produces a stern wake when that vessel is within a distance of less than 100 feet from the boat ramp and;

WHEREAS, the No Wake Zone will be properly marked with No Wake Zone signs and any person operating a vessel in violation is guilty of a non-criminal violation as defined in Florida Statutes 775.08.
